DISCUSSION	<p>The 100th day just passed. The school up in enrollment by 6.1% this year. There has been a big increase thanks to Ms. Carmen. Attendance has improved-it has been above 90% for past couple months which is high for the district. This could be used towards Cafecito, Title 1, the Spring Festival...</p> <p>PTA- The PTSA met and officially voted in the board, getting into compliance.</p> <p>Operations- The mouse problem is being addressed, putting in new traps. Additionally, they are going to replace all the door sweeps to help keep unwanted creatures out. Budgets will be coming soon from the district- Title 1 funding is dependent on bills going through the state. Staffing-as of now, no positions need to be filled.</p>
